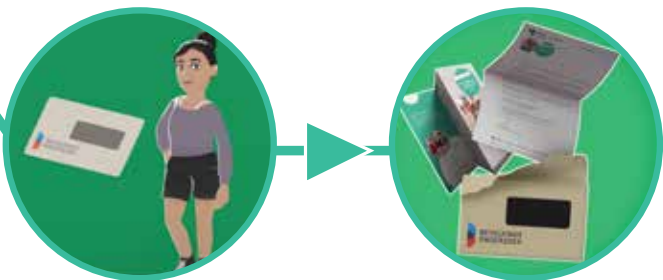


SMEAR EVERY 3 YEARS I WOMEN AGED 25 UP TO 29 YEARS

1 INVITATION



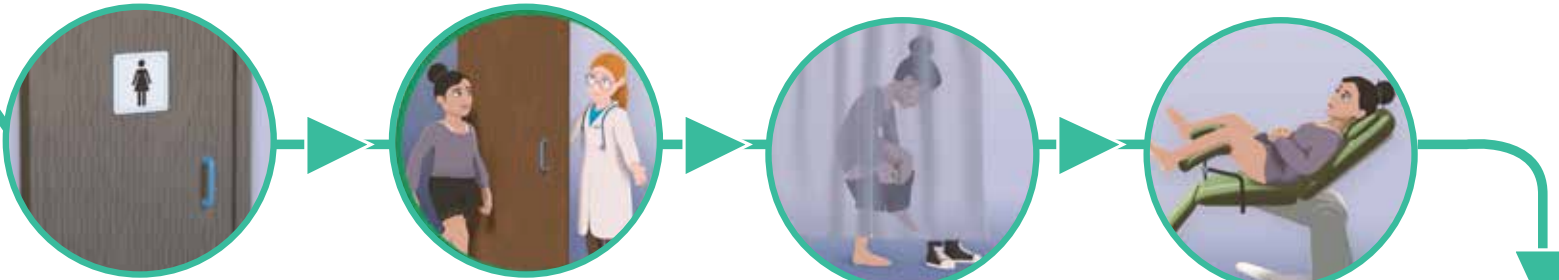
You will receive an invitation by post if your last smear test was more than 3 years ago.

2 MAKING AN APPOINTMENT WITH THE DOCTOR



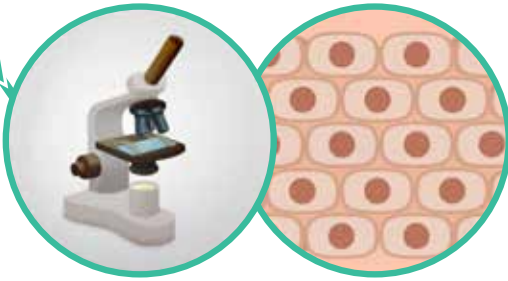
Make an appointment with your GP or gynaecologist for a smear test. For the appointment, choose a day when you are not menstruating.

3 HAVING A SMEAR TEST DONE BY THE DOCTOR

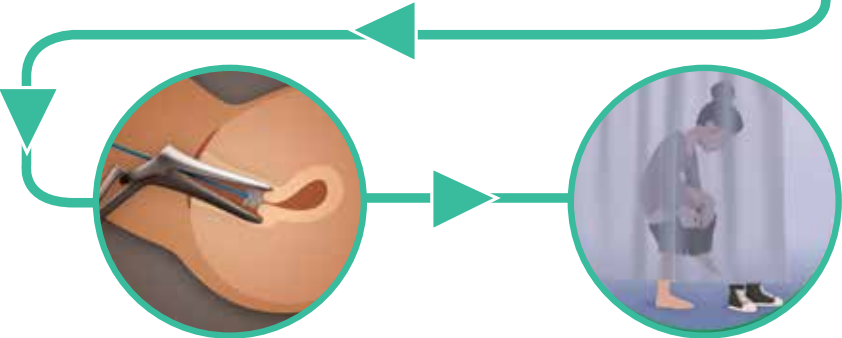


Go to the toilet first. The doctor calls you in when it is your turn. Undress from the waist down. Lie on the examination table with your legs in the supports.

4 SMEAR IN LAB



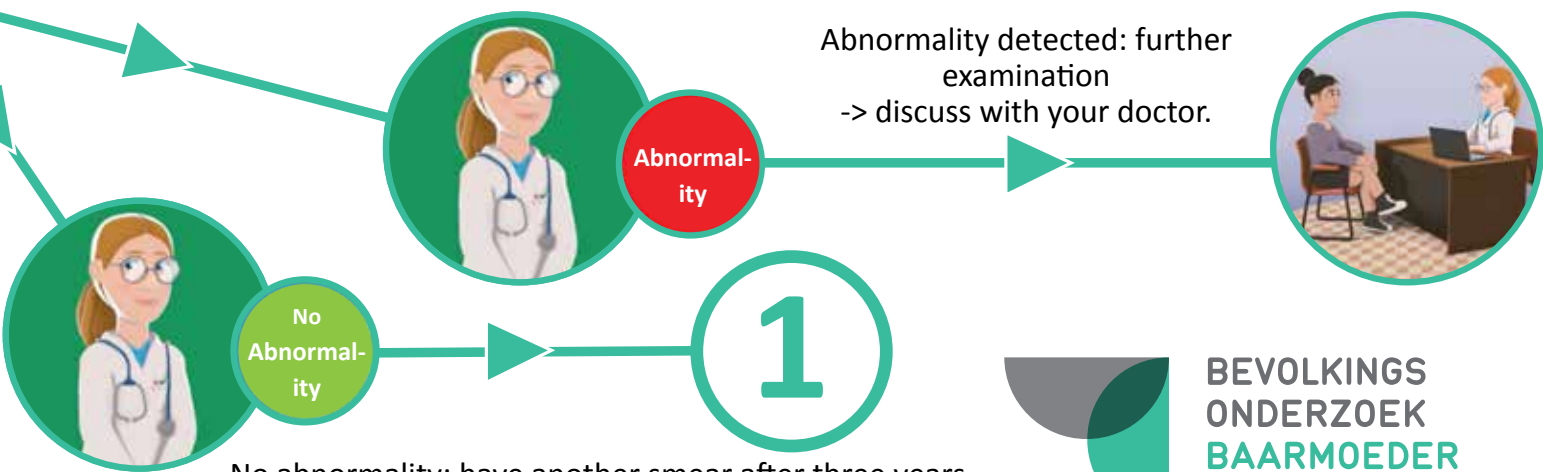
In the lab, the lab technician looks at the cells under the microscope.



The doctor gently inserts the duckbill into your vagina, takes some cells from your cervix with a brush and takes the duckbill out again. The examination is complete, and you may get dressed.

5 RESULT

The doctor who took the smear and your GP will get the result. You can also access the result yourself online at myhealth.be.
